How do you know if a patient qualifies?

Eligible candidates for our rehabilitation program must meet the following requirements:

- Has a disability which shows reasonable prognosis for increased function with the help of therapy services with the goal to go home.
- Must be willing and able to participate in a minimum of three hours of activity per day, five days a week.
- Has adequate community support upon discharge.
- Can set realistic goals that can be met within the average length of stay (5-8 days).
- A probable discharge plan should be available.
- Should be stable given the parameters of the diagnoses.
